#### STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The Ministerial Department affirms the importance of the local church in the fulfilment of Christ's commission. The Department thus assists the pastors, elders, leaders, and the diaconate in fulfilling this task. They are served in the following areas:

- 1. **Proclamation.** Keeping the pastors ever conscious that their first calling is for the proclamation of the Word to the Church and the world, presenting Jesus as Saviour and Lord to all people regardless of race, gender, nationality, tribe, or economic status.
- 2. **Personal growth.** Encouraging pastors in their personal growth, fostering a vibrant relationship with God that yield a strong sense of self-worth and pastoral mission.
- 3. Professional growth. Promoting the professional growth of pastors in the study and practice of ministry, representing their interests at the local conference, and enhancing the image of the pastoral ministry in order to attract qualified persons and keep them in its ranks. Training seminars will be continued so that the pastors, elders, leaders, and diaconate can be more fully furnished to carry forward the mission of the Church. These training seminars will allow the opportunity for more elders to be certified and more leaders and the diaconate to be ordained.
- 4. **Church growth.** Enabling pastors to nurture their congregations so they may be centres of loving concern, dynamic evangelism, and the presence of the living Lord.

#### **PROGRAMMES**

#### • Elder's Baptism day and Certification

Every Elder working with at least three candidates toward their baptism, and to be granted the permission to perform said baptisms. Every Elder to be prepared for the Elders Certification day that Sabbath.

#### Heritage Quiz

The Heritage Quiz is an annual programme organized through the Ministerial Department of the Jamaica Union. Members are encouraged to focus on specified periods of the local and global history of the church along with select Biblical books/passages.

Each congregation may enter the quiz with a team of six to eight individuals which must include an elder, a child and a youth. The goal is to encourage a greater appreciation for the history of the church and improve Biblical knowledge.

#### • Parish Administrative Cell (P.A.C.)

This group is comprised of all pastors assigned to the particular geographical location of the parish, select school administration, and elders.

The P.A.C. guidelines require the presence of Elders in order to appropriate Conference-Wide Development (C.W.D.) funds.

#### P.A.C. Meetings are held as follows:

**Hanover-** Third Wednesday of every other month beginning January

St. Elizabeth- First Tuesday of every other month beginning January

St. James- Second Thursday of each month

Westmoreland- Second Wednesday monthly

#### • Pastoral Evaluation

Pastors are evaluated by the local church boards twice annually:

- 1. In July, to cover the period January June
- 2. In January, to cover the period July December of the previous year.

Evaluations should be done at a duly called board meeting permitted by the pastor, yet with his absence. Responses are to be given prayerfully and honestly. Evaluation results will

have no punitive consequences but will aid the Administration in devising strategies for improving pastoral performance and service delivery.

#### • Parish Mission Seminars

The Parish Mission Seminars are organized on a parish basis in collaboration with other Departmental Directors to further equip the local church officers for service. It provides added training in leadership, facilitates one-to-one interaction and rapport, and facilitates the sharing of best practices in ministry leadership at the local Church.
